This book is a guide to the law that applies in the three international criminal tribunals, for the former Yugoslavia, Rwanda and Sierra Leone, set up by the United Nations during the period 1993 to 2002 to deal with atrocities and human rights abuses committed during conflict in those countries. Building on the work of an earlier generation of war crimes courts established in the aftermath of the Second World War, the three tribunals have developed a sophisticated body of law concerning the elements of the three international crimes (genocide, crimes against humanity and war crimes), forms of participation in such crimes as well as other general principles of international criminal law, procedural matters and sentencing. The legacy of the tribunals will be indispensable as international law moves into a more advanced stage, with the creation of the International Criminal Court. The book provides a comprehensive overview of the law of the tribunals, relying on their judicial decisions

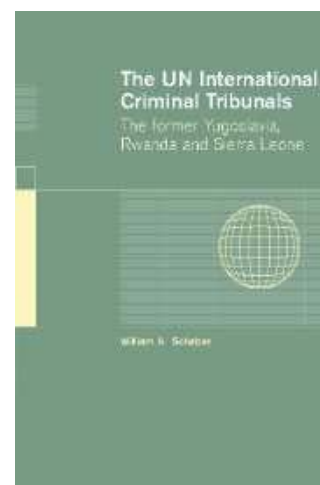

## The Pedagogy of Legal Writing for Legal Academics in Africa March 15-17, 2007 Nairobi, Kenya

The Pedagogy of Legal Writing Conference - Nairobi

Seattle University School of Law, the Legal Writing Institute (LWI), and the Association of Legal Writing Directors (ALWD) are proud to sponsor a conference on The Pedagogy of Legal Writing for legal academics from Africa.

Because the ability to communicate clearly, effectively, and persuasively is one of an attorney's greatest tools, law students must learn this skill. This conference will provide academics in Africa an opportunity to learn about the legal writings programs that have been developed in the United States. In addition, it will allow for academics from the United States to learn about how these skills are taught in African institutions.

The conference, which will take place at the Fairview Hotel in Nairobi, Kenya, on March 15-17, 2007, will be presented at no cost to the participants. In addition, depending on the number of participants, the sponsors may be able to help defray travel and/or accommodation costs for participants from Africa.

Who Should Attend: The conference is particularly appropriate for faculty who teach legal methods, advocacy, and legal drafting. Moreover, those faculty members who teach in clinical programs may benefit from the conference. Finally, law school deans and administrators are encouraged to attend.

Conference Format and Sessions: The conference will cover three main themes: (1) the emergence of legal writing as discipline; (2) the learning theory underpinning legal writing pedagogy; and (3) the "nuts and bolts" of teaching legal writing.

Many of the sessions will have a "hands-on" component, allowing the participants to try out the techniques and exercises explored in the sessions. In addition, the conference participants will have an opportunity to engage in "sharing sessions" to discuss the curriculum and methodology at their institutions with the other participants and conference presenters.

Conference Organizers: Professors Laurel Oates and Mimi Samuel, both of Seattle University School of Law, are the conference organizers. Professors Oates and Samuel teach in what the U.S. News and World Reports has ranked as the best legal writing program in the United States. Professor Oates is the Director of the program and has been teaching for 26 years; Professor Samuel has taught in the program for seven years and has eight years experience as a practicing attorney in Washington, D.C. and San Francisco, California. In addition, Professors Oates and Samuel have traveled to Uganda on two occasions to work with attorneys, judges, and law students there and will be teaching in Uganda and South Africa during 2007.
